TIM'S RAIDERS 28, DEATH CAMPERS 23

The champion was Tim's Raiders, owned by Tim Burnside, who compiled the best-ever overall record of 15-1 (16-week NFL season). The Raiders beat a new team, Death Campers, in the Fantasy Bowl, and in the the first round they avenged their only loss of the regular season (Radio Flyers). Through seven seasons since, the '88 Raiders remain the only team in league history that defeated every other the team in the league in the same season.

A.W.F.F.L. WEEKLY GAME SUMMARY - WEEK #14

What a season! Pete Rozelle wants parity? Look no further that the AWFFL! Six teams -- half of the league -- finish at 7-7; only two of those can go to the playoffs, and they are Division #1 winner **DEATH CAMPERS** and wild card winner **RADIO FLYERS**. The Campers never led their division (nor even had a .500 record), until the final week of the regular season, and were all but dead just a few weeks ago until winning five of their last seven games and rolling up some impressive point totals. They started the season 1-4, and were only 2-5 at the halfway point!

In the Division #1 championship game, the Campers went into Monday Night action trailing the **RADIO FLYERS** 19-15, with their only hope being Henry Ellard. After some major nail biting, Ellard scored in the third quarter to seal the victory and wrap up a storybook comeback to a once-dismal season. The Flyers still made the big show by virtue of beating all four of the other teams that had the same 7-7 record (**ROTO ROOTERS**, **ROUGH WRITERS**, **BILLS & ROMPERS**).

The Warriors have been in a mini-slump, averaging only 17 points while losing 2 of their last four games. But, better to have the slump during the season than in the playoffs, where the first opponent will be the red-hot Death Campers.

The Bills finished the season as the highest scoring team in the league with 390 points, followed by the Raiders with 387, the Warriors with 375, the Death Campers with 368 and Radio Flyers with 335.

A.W.F.F.L. WEEKLY GAME SUMMARY - WEEK #13

A record setting week for scoring as the playoff race comes down to the wire!

No team in the AWFFL had broken the 50-point barrier this season -- until this week, when FOUR TEAMS SCORED OVER 50 POINTS! This is an all-time AWFFL record. Another team had 45, and the lowest winning score this week was 39! In the previous 150 game history of the AWFFL, the 50-mark had been broken only five times - never this year, until this week!

The highest score ever in AWFFL was 67 in a playoff game; the regular season high of 53 was broken this week by **TIM'S RAIDERS** (54), and **DOC'S MIRACLE WORKERS** scored 52 to claim the third highest regular season score ever!

The real interest, however, is in the playoffs. **TIM'S RADIERS** clinched home field advantage for both games with a drubbing of **MOLINA'S MOLESTERS**, and **BUD'S WARRIORS** will still have home field advantage for his opening playoff game despite a bombardment from **DOC'S MIRACLE WORKERS**, who remain in the wild card chase.

The remaining two spots are up for grabs between five teams; three of those five control their own destiny -- a win, and they're in: **RADIO FLYERS**, **DEATH CAMPERS**, **ROMY'S ROMPERS**. This week's game between the Campers and the Flyers is for the Division championship. The Campers beat the Flyers once before, so if they do it again they would win on the first tie-breaker. If the Flyers win, they would have the best overall record in the division, and they would continue their season. If the Campers lose, they're out -- no chance for a wild card.

On the other hand, **ROMY'S ROMPERS**, who thrashed **HARDY'S HARDASSES**, can go to the playoffs as the wild card by beating **TIM'S RAIDERS**, who tuned up for the playoffs by waxing **MOLINA'S MOLESTERS**. If Romy can get by Tim (no small order), he would play Bud's Warriors the following week in the first playoff round.

For the other two teams still in the hunt, their fate is in the hands of others. The winner of the **DOC'S MIRACLE WORKERS** vs. **RONNIE'S ROTO ROOTERS** clash could win the wild card -- but, Tim must beat Romy for either to go, and for the Rooters to go, the Radio Flyers would have to win their game.
