Stu Bruisers become league's first two-time champion

WINNING RECIPE FOR STU!

With 18 points from their first-team All-AWFFL backfield (**Terrell Davis** and **Jamal Anderson**), complemented by two rookies in key positions — a quarterback and kicker — from one of the worst teams in the NFL (**Peyton Manning** and **Mike Vanderjagt**), the **Stu Bruisers** staked their claim as the AWFFL's first dynasty.

Davis and Anderson each scored nine, while the Colts top and bottom duo combined for 16, as the **Stu Bruisers** bopped **K.C.'s Rough Writers**, 40-36, in Fantasy Bowl XII.

The league's youngest franchise has now claimed the AWFFL title in every third year of its six-year existence, having joined the league for the '93 season and winning its first title in '95.

It was a battle of the league's best RBs against the league's top

WRs trio. In the end, the bottom line was the bottom game, where the Bruisers' four-point win was provided by a 13-9 cushion in the Kicking game.

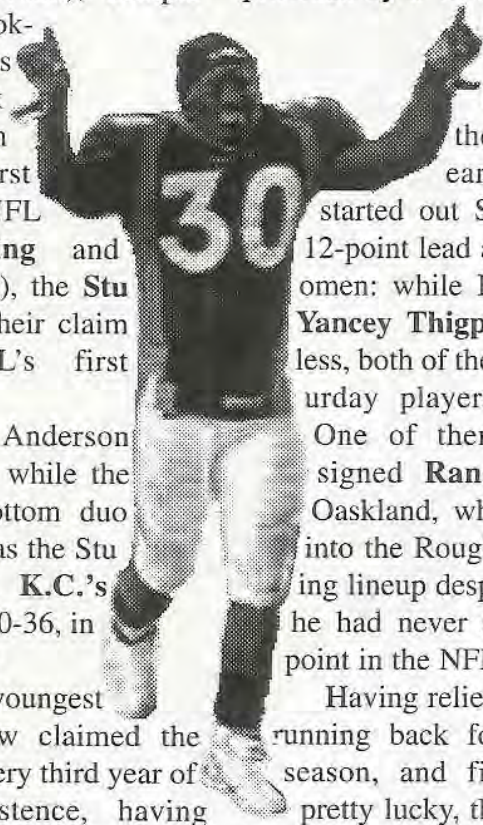
Things looked good for the Roughies early on. They started out Saturday with a 12-point lead and a very good omen: while Bruiser receiver **Yancey Thigpen** went scoreless, both of the Roughies' Saturday players scored TDs. One of them was newly-signed **Randy Jordan** of Oaskland, who was inserted into the Rough Writers' starting lineup despite the fact that he had never scored a single point in the NFL or AWFFL.

Having relied on pot luck at running back for most of the season, and finding the pot pretty lucky, they gambled on **Jordan**, instead of using their top-scoring (healthy) running back, **Leroy Hoard**. When **Jordan** scored in the Saturday late game, after

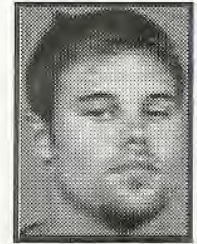
Hoard had failed to score in the early game, it appeared that the luck of the Roughies might be enough to overcome the scoring steamroller of the Big Brusing Machine.
